I look forward to seeing all of you at our next Club Meeting with our guest speaker Carey Chen!!

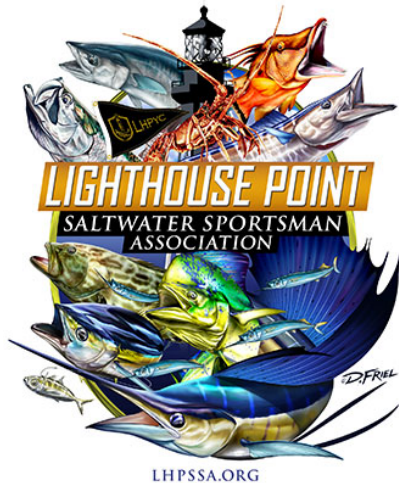

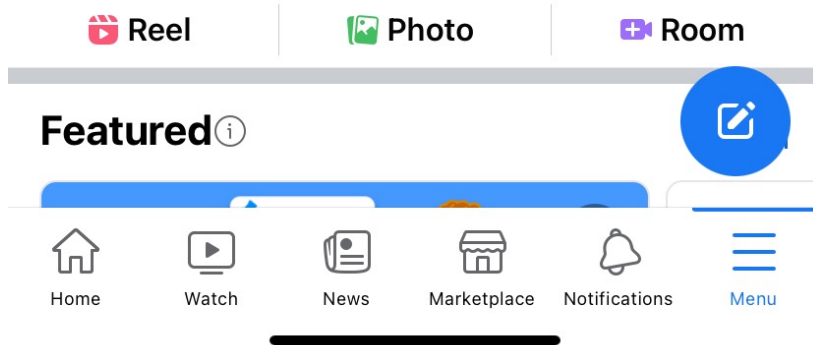

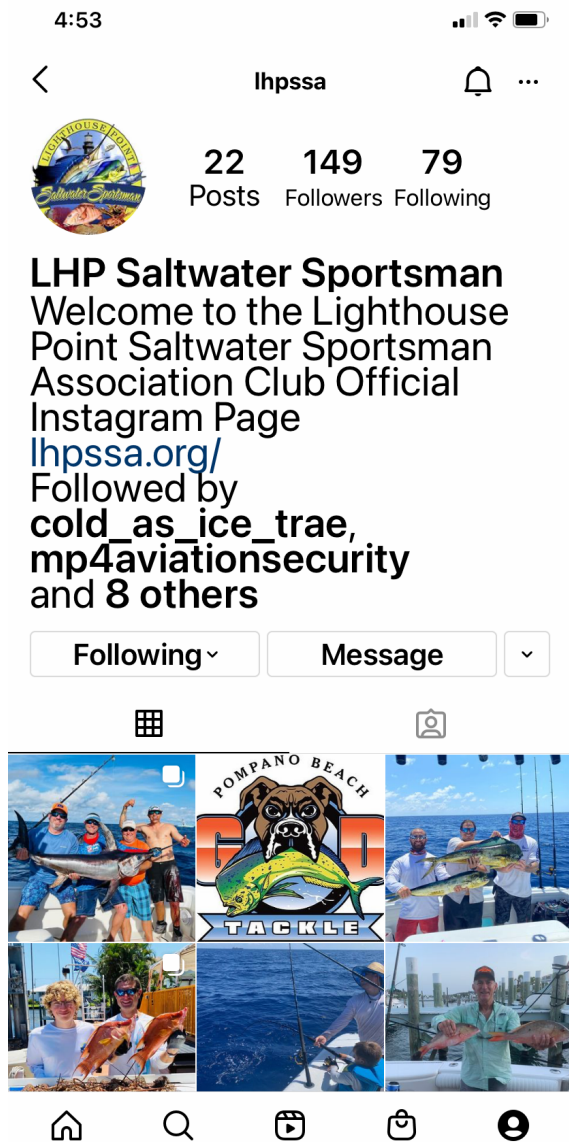
