Dive update:

Diving locally has been on fire the last month. A lot of the boats are getting their limits of lobsters every trip and spearing some nice fish, including hogfish, mutton and black grouper. The lobster have primarily been on the first and second reef. After some ear issues kept him out of the water for two months, Dr. Carl made a triumphant return to the water this past weekend by spearing a 20+ lb black grouper less than ½ mile from the inlet. And don't forget that it is usually about the first or second week of October that we get the lobster walking down the beach in about 10 feet of water. As soon as anyone gets word of that happening, put it out there on the WhatsApp group.
